January 21, 2021 @ 3 pm
Pinetops Town Hall**

Present: Present for the meeting were Mayor Brenda Harrell, Commissioners Donald Webb, Barbara Taylor, Dennis Sugg, and Oscar Mabry.

A. Call to Order

G. Items for Consideration


